All Dance Elements Company Members are held to a higher standard. In order to maintain a level of excellence, Dance Elements Company members have additional classes, rehearsal times, requirements and fees. If you can't meet these requirements, we have other performance opportunities that can accommodate any dancer at any level in a fun environment.

The Fusion Dance Company will compete at the highest competitive level of all of our companies. This company will compete in all styles such as Jazz, Lyrical, Open and Hip Hop. They will have 3 days of rehearsal every week on top of their other companies and 2 additional core classes. Fusion will be expected to compete at 2 competitions and will also attend a convention/ competition each competition season. This is a huge commitment and opportunity for the most dedicated dancer that wants to achieve the highest level of dance.

- All Company Members are required to take 2 additional core classes.

- Parents of NEW and RETURNING Fusion Dance Company members MUST complete the Company Application and Parent/Student Agreement. Please give your paperwork to Annette on the first day of your company class Season 2022/2023.
- Your placement is based on previous training, prior class attendance, attitude, work ethic and Summer Camp involvement.
- Rehearsals are held weekly. Required additional classes must be taken separately. (See the class requirements listed at the bottom of the page)
- The Fusion Dance Companies may perform for some local High School Halftime Shows and Parades.
- ALL Fusion Dance Company Members and chosen competition classes will attend 1 Competition per season. This Competition is called “KAR” and will take place in Coeur D’ Alene, ID February 17th-19th. Dance Elements will reserve rooms at both Holiday Inn Express and Staybridge Suites, with Group Rates for this Event. ____ (Initial Here)
- Fusion Dance Company will attend the Dance Convention/ Competition REVEL in Billings, MT March 24th-26th. This company will compete at a 3rd competition, however schedules are not available yet for the 2022/2023 Season. We will either travel to Billings, MT or Coeur D’ Alene, ID.
